## Riviere Towans Chalet Camp General Site Guidelines/Rules V01/23

We would like everyone who visits our site to have a peaceful and enjoyable time and therefore we request that the following rules are observed:

- Please observe the speed limit of 10mph whilst driving on our site
- Camping on the site is not permitted, whether in a tent, vehicle or otherwise
- In the interests of Hygiene and Health & Safety please do not feed the seagulls
- Whilst we welcome Dogs on the site, please ensure that:
  - They are always kept on a lead
  - They are kept under control
  - They are not left in a property / vehicle unattended for a prolonged period or to cause inconvenience to others
  - You clear up after them and dispose of the waste responsibly
- Due to the inherent risk of fire, the following are not permitted on site:
  - Open fires including but not limited to Fire Pits, Chimineas and similar
  - Disposable Barbecues\*
  - Fireworks (Also due to noise pollution)
    - \* Barbecues that are supported off the ground by legs are permitted (subject to individual chalet occupation rules) but safety is paramount when using this type of apparatus and common sense should prevail i.e., do not leave it unattended at any time and ensure it is completely extinguished once you have finished using it
- Please park your car with consideration for your neighbours. Please ensure your car is locked when unattended and valuables are removed. The Management Company cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to personal possessions or vehicles.
- Drones, with or without recording devices and model aircraft etc., are banned throughout the site. Please do not fly kites in the areas of site that have overhead cables.
- For the enjoyment of all, please be considerate to all users of the site and keep any noise to a minimum after 10pm
- Please dispose of your waste responsibly. We encourage recycling and there are numerous bin enclosures throughout the site that cater for the differing types of recycled products as well as General Waste.

Please be aware that our site is undulating with varying gradients and therefore is not uniformly level. We also have rabbits that dig holes, so please take care when walking or driving around our site.
